Mr. Joel Baucom, age 68 of the Minnick Community, died Thursday, July 29, 2021 at his residence.

He was born April 19, 1953 in Dyersburg, Tennessee the son of the late Henry Baucom and Betty (Roark) Baucom of Dyersburg. He was a letter carrier for the US Postal Service in Dyersburg, a US Army Veteran, and a member of the Sons of Confederate Veterans Mechanized Cavalry.
