Malcolm Edward Puckett, age 96 of Obion, died Monday, Sept. 3 at his residence. Mr. Puckett was the son of the late Jim and Emma (Waggoner) Puckett and was born in the Elbridge Community. He retired as a farmer in 1987 after 62 years of farming. Mr. Puckett was a member of the Mt. Moriah Baptist Church, where he served as a deacon for 77 years. He was elected to the Board of Directors of the Mt. Moriah Cemetery in 1953 and served in that capacity for 57 years. He also served as an Obion County Commissioner for 14 years. He is survived by a daughter and son-in-law Carolyn and Ed Cook of Obion; two grandchildren Sabrina (Puckett) Branch and husband Zack of Memphis and Cindy Cook of Bartlett; four great grandchildren Reese and Lexy Branch of Memphis and Nicolas and Cameron Cook of Springfield, TN; one nephew Jimmy Green of Woodland Mills. In addition to his parents, Mr. Puckett was preceded in death by his first wife Mary Lou (Barnett) Puckett, 10-18-1994; his second wife Zelma (Taylor) Puckett 6-25-2011; a son Jerry Puckett; a grandson Matt Cook; a brother Wayne Puckett; two sisters Aileen Dean and Bernice Green.
