Mrs. Maxine Revell Hughes, age 91 of Cordova, formerly of Obion, died Saturday, February 8, 2020 at Methodist Germantown Hospital in Germantown. Funeral services will be at 1 PM on Friday, February 14 at the First United Methodist Church in Obion where she was a member.
