Nathan Wyatt Cunningham, age 83 of Obion was the son of the late George Reeves and Eula Beatrice Sadler Cunningham. He was born in Obion County July 27, 1930. Mr. Cunningham was a farmer, a dozier operator and served as Obion County Sheriff from 1972 until 1978 and again from 1982 until 1990. Between these years as serving as sheriff, Mr. Cunningham service as a deputy sheriff. He was the 1978 president of the Tennessee Sheriff's Association. He was an Army Veteran, serving as a Medic in Germany. Mr. Cunningham was a member of the Obion Chapel United Methodist Church. He is survived by his wife Mable Davis Cunningham. They married January 8, 1950.
