Robert Marvin Wilson, age 94 of McKenzie, formerly of Obion County, died Wednesday, June 7 at Huntingdon Health & Rehab in Huntingdon, TN. He was born in Obion on May 15, 1923, the son of the late Robert A. and Amanda Hope (McCant) Wilson. He was a general employee of the former Forcum-Lannom Co. in Obion and a member of the Obion First United Methodist Church. Mr. Wilson served in the army during WWII from 1941 until 1945. He was married to Willo Wanda (Crossno) Wilson and she preceded him in death on July 15, 2003. 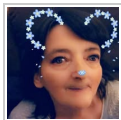
